ORDER

On January 17, 2019, the Court held a conference call with both counsel for the Government and Defendant Eric Brian Brown's ("Defendant") counsel to discuss scheduling a hearing on restoration of competency. The Court has scheduled this hearing for **February 27, 2019** in Norfolk, Virginia. To facilitate this matter, the Court **DIRECTS** Defendant's counsel to indicate no later than **February 13, 2019** whether they wish to call a testifying expert to challenge the finding of restoration of competency and to provide the appropriate documents regarding such expert to the United States. Further, the Court **DIRECTS** Defendant's counsel to inform the Government whether they wish to maintain Defendant in the medical facility in Butner, North Carolina or in the Hampton Roads area. If Defendant's counsel wishes for the latter, the Court **DIRECTS** the United States to ensure an adequate facility is available to provide Defendant with the requisite medical care he requires to maintain competency.

With respect to arraignment, that decision will be made based upon the outcome of the February 27, 2019 restoration of competency hearing. If the Court determines that Defendant has been restored to competency, he will be arraigned on the same day after the hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
